<b>Duration</b>	Group formed in 1993 and has continued since
<b>Description</b>	Assists in the management of the natural environment of the Iluka Peninsula and surrounding areas. Works closely with the National Parks & Wildlife Service.
<b>Projects List or Describe</b>	Weed eradication to allow natural regeneration of the remnant rainforest patch between Woody Head and the World Heritage Rainforest.
<b>NRM outcomes</b>	Have carried out many projects over the past 20+ years including weed control, planting, propagating native plants for Koala food and habitat, raising awareness of environmental issues. Saved the WH Rainforest from being taken off the list - through community action. Hosted various conservation teams in the area.
